Return to School/Work Criteria*



Must meet ALL three criteria in ONE of these columns



Symptoms have improved.

For Someone Who Is a Close Contact of a Confirmed COVID-19 Case Must meet ALL criteria below



Must quarantine until 10 days[‡] after date of last exposure and if continued exposure, 10 days after the confirmed case is released from isolation.

Monitor for any COVID-19-like symptoms of illness for 14 days.

*Based on the Hawaii State Department of Health's COVID-19 Interim Return to Work/School Guidance. [†]When there is low-suspicion of COVID-19 or diagnosis of another health condition (e.g. allergy, asthma or flu), a medical provider may use clinical judgment to allow return to school/work.

[‡]Someone who has been fully vaccinated or has had COVID-19 and recovered in the past three months is not required to quarantine following additional exposure and may go to school/work as long as they do not develop new symptoms.
